2023 began with the *Prehistoric Pop-Up* exhibit in the Montague/Urschel Gallery. Upon its closing on April 30, the exhibit travelled to Cedar Lake and was installed at the Museum at Lassen's Resort from May through October.

The featured exhibit, Ever Yours: Postcards from the Golden Age, ran from May 12, 2023, through January 7, 2024, in the Montague/Urschel Gallery and was the primary exhibit for 2023. Over 400 postcards from our collection were displayed, including 150 original artifacts and 250 transcribed reproductions. A "pop-up" booth featuring content from *Ever Yours* was installed at the Porter County Fair from July 20 to 29.

The Robert Cain Gallery hosted four small exhibits throughout the year, each including different selections of artwork from our permanent collection. *Connections*, our permanent exhibit in the Eunice Slagle Gallery, saw an update in September. Seven new pairings (twenty artifacts) were added.

During 2023, the PoCo Muse continued to offer free weekly guided museum tours every Saturday. From November onward, the time was changed from noon to 2p in response to visitor feedback. An additional Curated Tour with Quinn Albert, Visitor Experience Manager, was offered each quarter, providing in-depth stories and featured objects not normally on display.

Pamela Murrow presented a history talk on her transcription of Morgan Township farmer John B. DeCrow's 1866-1890 diaries. Ian Baker and his band of living-history interpreters continued to offer their popular public programming with themed reenactments each quarter on the courthouse lawn. Executive Director Kevin Matthew Pazour hosted a public tour of Old City Cemetery and a downtown fire-history walking tour. For PoCo Muse supporters, he offered two behind-the-scenes museum tours. History Happy Hour, a quarterly local-history social gathering at a neighborhood pub, began in July.
